6. Subsequently, the agents wanted to know, while at the Gold Club with Mr. Marchelletta, Jr., what was Mr. Marchelletta, Jr.'s method of payment, cash or credit card. I stated I did not know how much or by what method Mr. Marchelletta, Jr. had paid.
