In March 21, 2000, a telephonic interview was held with a confidential informant (CI) controlled by Special Agent Mark Sewell, FBI, Atlanta, Georgia. The interview was conducted at the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task force (OCDETF) office, Atlanta, Georgia. Present during the interview was special Agent Mark Sewell, FBI, Special Agent Lynn Whittaker, IRS, and Special Agent Kimberly Sellers, SAIC/Atlanta.

The interview was conducted in association with an investigation of THE CIRCLE SROUP LTD. On March 16, 2001, three endorsed checks with a value of over \$1.5 million dollars were seized by Customs at the Federal Express hub in Memphis, Tennessee. The checks were from the CIRCLE GROUP LTD, Alpharetta, Georgia, and were being sent to H & J CORPORATE SERVICES, Nassau, Bahamas. Corporate records obtained through Georgia Secretary of State's office listed Gerard C. 4ARCHELLETTA SR. as registered agent, and David C. GUNDERSON, as applicant.

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The CI worked as a bodyguard/personal assistant for GERARD MARCELLETTA and EORGE GORMAN for approximately two years, from late 1997 until October 1999. The CI stated that during that time, they "went everywhere with them." The CI tated that MARCHELLETTA et al paid for the CI's townhouse, car and weekly expenses. The CI also stated that if they weren't with GORMAN or IARCHELLETTA, they were with their family "flying around the US."

he CÍ stated that MARCHELLETTA and GORMAN owned a company named "LA :ONTRACTORS", a drywall company that contracted out to major hotels and The CI stated that LA CONTRACTORS was one of only four or five rywall companies in the United States that contracted out for such large projects. The CI stated that CIRCLE INDUSTRIES (CIRCLE) was a business that IARCHELLETTA was involved in with his father Gerard MARCHELLETTA Sr. MARCHELLETTA Sr.) who resides in New York. The CI stated that MARCHELLETTA am the day-to-day-operations of CIRCLE. According to the CI, CIRCLE ontracted drywall services through hotel construction and provided drywall or stadiums and hotels. The CI stated that CIRCLE has completed work on urner Field, and Georgia Tech stadium, Atlanta, Georgia, and football tadiums in Jacksonville, Florida, and Charlotte, North Carolina. CIRCLE also ad a contract for drywall services with the owner of 15 Marriott Hotel ranchises. (The CI couldn't remember the man's name, but said that he was ocated in New Orleans, LA, and described him as "an old man with a French ame"). CIRCLE is also working on phase eight (out of 12 phases) for the TLANTIS, Paradise Island, Bahamas. In addition to CIRCLE and LA CONTRACTORS, ther MARCHELLETTA businesses include: partial involvement in TIMBERLAKE ORTGAGE, and several other mortgage companies (names unknown) located north f Atlanta. The business composition is as follows:

ARCHELLETTA SR. owns CIRCLE in New York; he and another MARCHELLETTA son run t. MARCHELLETTA run the Atlanta division, although MARCHELLETTA SR. "swaps" ith Atlanta sometimes. The CI also stated that MARCHELLETTA'S father "helps" ARCHELLETTA out.

he CI went on to state that GORMAN and MARCHELLETTA had a goal to open everal additional businesses and have people manage them for the purpose of aundering money.

ARCHELLETTA originally received money to begin his business career from ARCHELLETTA SR. in New York. The CI believes that MARCHELLETTA SR. has roperty in Manhattan, a house on Long Island, and another house elsewhere in ew York. The CI stated that he believed that MARCHELLETTA SR. had ties to rganized crime (OC). The CI stated that he would travel to New York requently with MARCHELLETTA. While in New York they would attend sporting vents such as the NY Knicks or the NY Yankees games. On one occasion, ARCHELLETTA SR. introduced the CI to a "well known" OC figure. The CI eclined to name the OC figure.

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he CI stated that MARCHELLETTA involved MARCHELLETTA SR. in large business leals involving CIRCLE. CIRCLE "courts" the Presidents and CEOs of large acilities and hotels, and pays them off to obtain their business. The CI ould provide transportation for the Presidents and CEOs. The CI stated that in a routine basis, he would have an envelope containing anywhere from \$20,000 o \$100,000.00. This envelope would be given to the Presidents or CEO upon heir arrival to Atlanta or at their departure from Atlanta. They would be intertained courtesy of CIRCLE at establishments in the Metropolitan Atlanta rea including Bones Restaurant, Chops Steakhouse and The Gold Club strip bar. Following a joint investigation by the FBI and IRS, the owner of The Gold lub, Steve Kaplan is currently under a multi-count indictment in the Northern istrict of Georgia. The indictment includes charges of extortion, money aundering, prostitution, and racketeering. The case is currently in the rial process).

coording to the CI, GORMAN and MARCHELLETTA are "best friends", and that ARCHELLETTA and GORMAN "gave money to each other."

ARCHELLETTA was the "moneyman" while GORMAN was the "mastermind" at CIRCLE. he CI stated that GORMAN "had his hand in all the pots".

nother individual, Jim BOOKER was the "investor/money hider", while yet nother individual Cris RISHER handled the day to day aspects of the business. he CI stated that MARCHELETTA would tell GORMAN to tell RISHER what to do, nd that MARCHELETTA let GORMAN and RISHER do "the dirty work". MIKE OMENICHI and ANTHONY COTRINO established and/ or maintained different counts to hide money. Although GORMAN was the "brains" and did the actual ork for the company, GORMAN was never the CEO; he was always listed as eneral Manager and was a partner in the business; RISHER'S is listed as the wner of LA CONTRACTORS. RISHER was born in the US, but reared in Mexico. He as a ranch in the Charlotte. North Carolina area.

he CI identified the following as MARCHELLETTA involved companies: MSB RYWALL, EAGLE MANAGEMENT, LA CONTRACTORS, LA AMERICA, and T & T DRYWALL (bank brough Scotia Bank in the Bahamas)

he CI stated that approximately two years ago (1999) CIRCLE did a lot of usiness for the ATLANTIS resort, Paradise Island, Bahamas. The CI stated hat SAUL KRISHNER is the owner of the ATLANTIS. According to the CI, RISHNER, a South African national, owns six casinos worldwide, and was thrown out" of South Africa for reasons unknown to the CI. According to the I, KRISHNER employs between 6,200 to 6,300 people; approximately 70% of those mployed in the Bahamas. JIM BOOKER is the CEO of KRISHNER'S company.

he CI discussed payments that occurred in the Bahamas. The CI stated that if the money didn't go through the Bahamas, it would go through Florida".

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he CI stated that they used a bank block away from the ATLANTIS hotel in ahamas. The CI also stated that he felt that any money they MARCHELLETTA/GORMAN /RISHNER) laundered was their own money. The CI stated hat the ATLANTIS "is making money hand over fist", and that KRISHNER paid hem each \$1.5 million for the ATLANTIS.

A CONTRACTORS was another MARCHELLETTTTA involved drywall business. GORMAN nd CRIS RISHER along with his two brothers ran LA CONTRACTORS and yet another ry wall company. According to the CI, RISHER headed LA CONTRACTORS, but ORMAN was the "brains" of the organization. The CI stated that there are ery few drywall businesses in existence that specialize in large-scale rywall such as hotels, and sports arenas.

coording to the CI, GORMAN and RISHER were "on the outs". RISHER was spending oo much money, they were afraid of attention from the IRS, and wanted him out". RISHER was given a "few million dollars" and left the company. GORMAN hanged LA CONTRACTORS to EAGLE last year. According to the CI, GORMAN would put money into LA CONTRACTORS and let it sit".

he CI also stated that LA CONTRACTORS became "huge", and that LA CONTRACTORS nd CIRCLE worked closely together. CIRCLE would obtain the contract, and the abor would come from LA CONTRACTORS. LA CONTRACTORS was brought in if a IRCLE job was "huge".

ORMAN handled labor for LA CONTRACTORS, and would frequently travel to and rom Mexico to handle aspects of the business. GORMAN would bring illegal liens in to the US to drywall. GORMAN would pay a man in Mexico City 50,000.00 -\$100.000.00 per month to bring the illegal workers through hihuahua, MX and then into Texas using false documents. The worker's upervisors would be Anglo, and the workers Hispanic. They would pay their orkers \$7.00 -\$8.00/hour to install dry wall, and then charge the companies hat they were working for between \$30.00 -\$40.00/hour.

n addition to his participation in LA CONTRACTORS, GORMAN also had a company n Arkansas. The CI didn't know the name of the company. Through this, GORMAN ad contact with an unnamed woman in Arkansas, who was in the dry wall usiness also. According to the CI, she and GORMAN examined businesses that ere conducive to money laundering including car lots, car washes, and ortgage companies. The woman also "shuffled" money through GORMAN. ARCHELLETTA/GORMAN/and woman in Arkansas went off into business together. The I stated that the woman in Arkansas owns a lot of property outside Little ock.

he CI stated that GORMAN's father is a Puerto Rican citizen and resident. The

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though that GORMAN's mother is from Puerto Rico also. The CI thought that)RMAN was born in Puerto Rico, but had lived in Ohio at some point, possibly) attend college. The CI stated that GORMANS's father owns a large Pepsi actory and car dealership in San Juan. The CI also stated that GORMAN's ther is "well off" financially, and assists GORMAN "a lot" by "hiding ings" (i.e. money and /or assets) in San Juan. The CI stated that GORMAN ither had and/or still has businesses in Puerto Rico. The CI stated that)RMAN co-owns a new car dealership in San Juan. According to the CI, GORMAN erns approximately \$25,000.00 to \$ 50,000.00 per month from the car palership; the CI believes that GORMAN he may be trying to sell the car ealership. According to the CI. GORMAN owns the rights to the equivalent of ie "Icee" frozen beverage in Puerto Rico. The CI also stated that GÓRMAN raveled monthly to Puerto Rico, and would also travel to Mexico. The CI tated that GORMAN distrusted Mexican banks, and usually carried a laptop imputer with him. The CI stated that GORMAN would pay his wife approximately 1.000.00 per week in spending money. GORMAN had two or three Nations Bank counts and two or three bank accounts in the Bahamas. He would structure s transactions between \$4,500.00 and \$5,000.00.

IRMAN was interested in owning a detail shop to flush money through. GORMAN 'lushed" money through a Mortgage Company (believed to be TIMBERLAKE MORTGAGE se below). According to the CI, a lawyer located next to LA CONTRACTORS amed TOM LNU conducted many transactions on their behalf. TOM LNU was paid stly by check, but sometimes cash. TOM LNU traveled a great deal to Miami and the Bahamas. (S/A Sewell/ FBI is believed to have TOM LNU's full name; strification of this information is currently pending).

IRMAN had several business trips to Switzerland. Apparently, a group of liss businessmen were building a large shopping mall in America. He also raveled to the Bahamas frequently. While in the Bahamas, GORMAN fell in love tha Czech woman and began steps to leave his wife. The woman owned a Hugo issistore in the Bahamas and was married to a lawyer who practiced in the thamas. GORMAN met the woman's husband through an attorney he uses to induct "pay offs" in order to obtain necessary licenses. Payoffs were also inducted in association with the stadiums in Jacksonville, FLA and Charlotte, In the CI also stated that GORMAN was paying off a woman in the Bahamas letails unknown). The CI also alleged that GORMAN would "skim money off the ip" from RISHER, and travel to Mexico to hide the money.

To CI also stated that GORMAN wanted to open a casino in the Bahamas. Tom U flew to the Bahamas to make the necessary arrangements. The CI flew to be Bahamas, went to the bank and withdrew \$20,000.00 and paid hamas National license at the carport behind Scotia Bank in the Bahamas.

TOKER is the CEO of KRISHNER'S company SUN CITY INTERNALTONAL that developed

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e Atlantis project, Paradise Island, Bahamas. According to the CI, BOOKER ves in the Orlando, Florida area. BOOKER's daughter lives in the Atlanta, area; therefore BOOKER would visit Atlanta often. KRISHNER and BOOKER uld dine together when BOOKER came to town. The CI acted as a driver for OKER and his wife when they visited Atlanta, and on two or three occasions, e CI gave BOOKER an envelope containing \$25,000.00 cash. The CI stated that RCHELLETTA et al wanted to keep BOOKER happy so he would provide them with siness.

e CI elaborated that most of the money exchanges occurred in the Bahamas assau/Paradise Island). The CI deemed it, "what can you do for me" money. RMAN/RISHER/MARCHELLETTA received \$ 1 million from RISHNER. On one occasion, OKER gave two Porsche Boxsters to GORMAN and MARCHELLETTA as a gratuity. e CI went with Jeff CLEVELAND to Florida to pick them up. The CI signed for em; they were in MARCHELLETTA's name.

MSERLAKE MORTGAGE was another MARCHELLETTA involved company. JEFF CLEVELAND smade president of TIMBERLAKE MORTGAGE. CLEVELAND formerly worked for tions Bank. According to the CI, while employed by Nations Bank, CLEVELAND scaught sending money to a bank in Mexico and was fired on the spot. The believes that the bank in Mexico is possibly located in Mexico City. EVELAND was fired and TIMBERLAKE was shut down. They spent a lot of money pproximately \$150,000.00) to start it up, and it didn't produce. They ened another mortgage type business in Suwanee, GA.

THE CI Stated that MARCHELLETTA and GORMAN concealed assets in their ildren's names. MARCHELLETTA has a son, also named JERRY. GORMAN had three ildren: Lauren, approximately 13 years old, Josh, approximately 10/11 years d, and another daughter, approximately one year old. The CI stated that the roose of placing assets in the children's names was to avoid taxes. The CI aimed that MARCHELLETTA and GORMAN were hiding money to avoid paying taxes, cause they wanted to retire in three years. The CI also stated that they all "talk about it all the time", and that they laundered millions per ar".

ea to open a sort of a sub-LA CONTRACOTRS nationwide. The employee reatened to kill RISHER's family and wanted the CI to provide assistance. e CI was in Raleigh, NC and was supposed to ride along as curity/protection, while a "whacked out marine" was to do the actual ling. The CI refused to do it, and shortly thereafter, ended their lationship with them. The CI claimed that after this occurred, their whhouse was "trashed". The CI also claimed that the last sum of money they er received from them occurred eighteen months when they received \$2,000.00.

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he CI stated that RISHER has a small ranch located in a subdivision of harlotte, NC. The CI estimated its value at approximately \$1 million. The CI tated that RISHER has a criminal history and bought a new BMW for his mother. ISHER also received \$1.5 million in the Bahamas from KIRSHNER. The CI tated that RISHER received a monthly allowance of \$50,000.00 to \$100,000.00, nd wanted to obtain an author to write a "rags to riches" book about himself i.e. from the ghettos of Texas to wealth). RISHER also wanted to buy a house ext to Saul KRISTNER in the Bahamas.

he CI was MARCHELLETTA et al's connection with the Gold Club. The CI requented the Gold Club with his employers (MARCHELLETTA and GORMAN) two to hree times per week. The CI stated that they would spend between \$30,000.00 nd \$40,000.00 per visit. The CI stated that they knew Steve KAPLAN, the wher of the Gold Club (currently under indictment in the Northern District of eorgia for a variety of charges including money laundering, and RICO iolations), and other individuals involved in the Gold Club's operations such as Ziggy/Norby/Ray/Cola/Patrick, all of whom have been involved in the old Club trial). The CI stated that MARCHELLETTA and GORMAN would "wine and ine clients". The CI stated that they would place food and drinks on their orporate card as expenses, and use cash to pay the dancers. The CI stated hat they would occasionally travel with the Gold Club girls. The CI claimed hat upon one occasion while in Dallas, TX, the CI traveled back to Atlanta, etrieved some of the dancers and then returned to Dallas with the dancers. he CI stated that their American Express bill would run between \$50,000.00 to 100,000.00 per month, and would be paid off in full each month.

ccording to the CI, GORMAN knew an Asian individual that operated a "Chinese rocery store" that laundered money for them. According to the CI, the Chinese rocery Store keeps approximately \$500,000.00 for them. The CI would take a heck to the Chinese grocery store and they would cash it. It is located off xit 85/Chamblee Tucker Road, across the street from a gas station. Take a eft over the bridge, grocery store shop store on right. The C.I. would ontact Mr./Mrs. Kim at he grocery store, and drop GORMAN'S name. The CI also tated that "all the Hispanics cashed their checks there". The CI also stated hat GORMAN went to the Chinese place all the time.

he CI was asked to identify several names in association with CIRCLE NDUSTRIES. He relayed the following information:

AVID GUNDERSON

possibly an accountant for CIRCLE

ARINA FITZGERALD

thought to be MARCHELLETTA sister (not believed to be true).

AICOS/BARBADOS

SORMAN and CLEVELAND "slushed" money through Barbados

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IKE RYAN

MARCHELLETTA "guy" at CIRCLE

ne CI was asked to identify banks used by CIRCLE et al. The CI stated that ations' Bank, First Union Bank, and a small bank in Miami were used by IRCLE. The CI also stated that MARCHELLETTA wanted to buy a bank and own his an bank.

ne CI referred to H & J CORPORATE SERVICES as "Scotia", stated that it was ormerly known as H & G, and referred to it as "Jerry's little thing in the shamas". The CI stated that it is a "made up company" used to flush money brough and is located on Paradise Island, The Bahamas.

he CI stated that RISHER would travel to the Bahamas on a private aircraft, pssibly using Peachtree Dekalb (PDK) general aviation facility, or would ravel commercially using Delta Airlines. The CI stated that MARCHELLETTA had private jet, and that they would fly out of PDK on Jerry's corporate jet. he CI stated that they did not own a jet, but that "Jerry wanted to own a jet ext". The CI stated that upon two or three occasion, they transported money pealed on their body to the Bahamas on behalf of MARCHELLETTA and GORMAN. he CI stated that they carried \$20,000.00 to \$50,000.00.The CI stated that erry traveled with a suitease that contained checks and cash.

ne CI identified the following as cities frequently traveled by MARCHELLETTA nd GORMAN: Dallas, TX (Marriott Hotel), New Orleans, LA, Miami, and Tampa, _A, Charlotte, NC, New York City (Sheraton Hotel), Little Rock, Arkansas, klahoma City, OK.

ne CI stated that GORMAN had a house in Bahamas, and was preparing to buy nother one. The CI believed that the house was located in the Holiday Inn roperties. The CI stated that GORMAN lives in the River Glen subdivision, ld Atlanta, Georgia area, while MARCHELLETTA lives in the Country Club of the buth area. The CI stated that MARCHELLETTA had a million dollar, 15,000 quare foot house in Alpharetta, GA. This angered GORMAN; thus he built nother, larger house.

arther identification is needed on the individuals named by the CI. The avestigation continues.
