Dear Mr. Bly:

Thank you for your discovery production conveyed to us under your transmittal letter dated March 26, 2012, received in our office on this past Friday, March 30, 2012.

As stated in your transmittal letter, your production responded to our Discovery Request No. 1 (first issued on August 18, 2011). Please note that your recent production did not respond fully to that request. You provided 95 pages of actual discovery, which is partially responsive to part two of that request. As you can see from the highlighted portion of the request on page two (attached), we also requested unredacted copies of "20 multi-page CBP reports . . ."

Under our transmittal letter of October 5, 2011 (also attached), we provided your office with the Customs reports that contained redactions to expedite your office's review and disclosure. For your further convenience, I am enclosing those reports again, in hardcopy form, and also attaching them in electronic form to my transmittal email being issued to you today.

Please disclose unredacted versions of these reports soonest. Upon our receipt of same, your office will have responded fully to our Discovery Request No. 1, reserving the issue of the appropriateness of any remaining redactions for a later date.
